NOTICE TO ALL USERS OF THE CITY OF LA GRANGE PARKS & RECREATION PROPERTIES

****WARNING: USE AT YOUR OWN RISK****

The City of La Grange Parks & Recreation Properties (the "Facility"), operated by The City of LaGrange Parks and Recreation Department, is a non-supervised public recreational facility intended for activities such as baseball, basketball, skateboarding, mountain biking, volleyball, cornhole, playground, splash pad, fishing, etc. By entering and using this Facility, you acknowledge and agree to the following terms and conditions:

1. ****Assumption of Risk****

Use of the Facility involves inherent risks, including but not limited to falls, collisions, equipment failure, and injuries due to uneven surfaces, weather conditions, or other users' actions. Serious injury, permanent disability, or death may result. By using the Facility, you voluntarily assume all risks associated with its use, whether known or unknown.

2. ****No Supervision Provided****

This Facility is not supervised by staff during regular hours of operation. Users are responsible for their own safety and conduct. Parents or legal guardians are responsible for supervising minors (under 18 years of age) and ensuring their compliance with all rules.

3. ****Rules and Regulations****

To ensure a safe and enjoyable experience, all users must follow these rules:

- Appropriate safety equipment (e.g., helmets, pads) is strongly recommended and may be required for certain activities (e.g., skateboarding, mountain biking).
- No alcohol, drugs, smoking, or vaping is permitted.
- No vandalism, littering, or unauthorized modifications to the Facility.
- Use the Facility only for its intended purpose (e.g., skateboarding on ramps, not on railings).
- Respect other users and maintain courteous behavior.

4. ****Liability Waiver****

By using the Facility, you agree that The City of La Grange and its agents, employees, or representatives are not liable for any injuries, damages, or losses sustained while using the Facility, except as provided by law. This includes injuries caused by the condition of the Facility, other users, or your own actions.

5. ****Emergency Procedures****

In case of an emergency, call 911 immediately. Users are responsible for arranging their own medical care or assistance.

6. ****Minors****

Parents or legal guardians are responsible for ensuring that minors under 18 comply with all rules and are adequately supervised. Minors use the Facility at their own risk, and parents/guardians assume full responsibility for any injuries or damages caused by or to the minor.

7. ****Compliance with Laws****

All users must comply with applicable Kentucky laws, including but not limited to KRS § 411.190 (recreational use statute), which limits liability for landowners providing public recreational facilities, provided users follow posted rules.

****NOTICE****: Failure to follow these rules may result in removal from the Facility, fines, or other penalties as permitted by law. The City of La Grange Parks & Recreation Department reserves the right to modify these rules or close the Facility at any time without notice.
